Without water, we would be poisoned to death by the waste products produced in our body, Kidneys remove from our body and and urea which are dissolved in water. Water is also vital for chemical reactions in digestion and metabolism It carries nutrients and oxygen to the cells through blood and helps to cool the body through perspiration By not drinking enough water, many people gain weight. It decreases their digestive efficiency and also affects the functioning of other organs. Proper water intake is a key to weight loss. If people who are trying to lose weight do not drink enough water, the body cannot metabolise the fat The minimum water intake for a healthy person is 30ml per kg of body weight a day. You need to drink more water if you live in hot climate. Drink as much water as you can. In the beginning, you may need to go to the bathroom frequently. But by and by, your bladder adjusts itself and you urinate less frequently but in larger quantity. So, start drinking more water than you usually drink.
